Check each skill if you observe that the child demonstrates achievement of the skill.

Birth to Three Months

- Lifts head when held on shoulder
- Smiles spontaneously
- Responds to bell or rattle
- Follows moving person with eyes
- Follows objects in a half-circle with eyes
- Vocalizes (not crying) such as "ah," "eh," or cooing

Three to Five Months

- Smiles responsively
- Laughs
- Rolls over
- In sitting position, head is erect and steady
- Smiles at mirror image
- Both hands approach offered object (ball or rattle)
- Begins crawling movements

Five to Nine Months

- Transfers objects from hand to hand
- Sits without support
- Squeals with joy or pleasure
- Reaches and grasps toy
- Holds two toys or two cubes

Six to Twelve Months

- Crawls or progresses on stomach or hitches in sitting position; progresses without walking
- Gets to sitting position alone
- Exhibits thumb-and-finger grasp or feels self cracker
- Imitates speech sounds
- Says "mama" and "daddy" (or variations) for mother and father
- Vocalizes four different syllables

Nine to Fifteen Months

- Cooperates in playing pat-a-cake
- Walks, holding furniture
- Stands alone
- Looks at pictures in baby picture book

Eleven to Fifteen Months

- Walks alone, toddling
- Uses a pincer grasp, as in picking up a raisin
- Indicates or gestures wants without crying
- Imitates words (record words the child uses):

- Drinks from a cup

Twelve to Eighteen Months

- Turns pages of a book
- Uses at least three words other than "mama" and "daddy" (or variations)
- Stacks two or more blocks
- Scribbles spontaneously

Fifteen to Twenty-Two Months

- Removes at least one garment
- Walks backward
- Stacks at least three blocks
- Walks up steps without help
- Carries and hugs doll or toy animal

Fourteen to Twenty-Seven Months

- Throws ball overhand
- Runs
- Uses spoon (without or without spilling)
- Names at least three objects or pictures of objects
- Points to parts of a doll (hair, mouth, hands, feet, etc.)
- Uses words to make wants known

Seventeen to Thirty Months

- Walks up steps alone
- Recognizes and points to at least five objects or pictures of objects
- Makes sentences of at least two or three words
