Potty Training



There has been a lot of interest expressed by parents about potty training lately. I've done some research and created a flyer (attached), about what age is a good age to start, signs of readiness, procedure used at Pamm's House, etc.

Many times, at diaper changing time, a child will ask to sit on the potty, and at any age, if a child asks to use the potty at Pamm's House I will gladly help them use it! It seems all the children, even though they are not mature enough yet, express an interest because of watching the older toddlers learn to use the potty. This is good practice.

Since potty training depends on many factors such as the maturity of the child, timing in the child's life, child's interest, etc., I will work with families on an individual basis so we can come up with the best plan for your child.

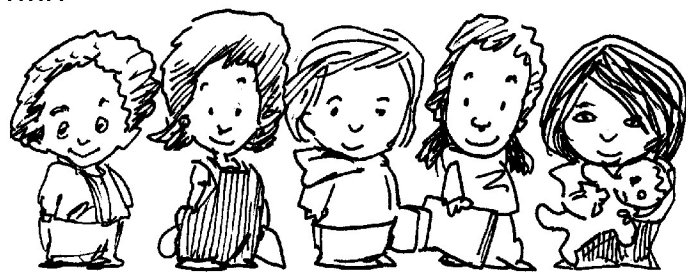
New Planning Chart
