

Motor	<b>Crawl Through the Grass</b> Explore textures by crawling through some grass.	<b>Crawl Under the Bridge</b> Make a bridge out of pillows or cushions. Crawl under it.	<b>Push and Pull</b> Increase gross and fine motor skills by pushing and pulling construction toys.	<b>Hard Hat On, Hard Hat Off</b> Learn to place objects with purpose by playing with a toy hard hat. Practice putting it on and off.	<b>Hide the Truck</b> Demonstrate object permanence by hiding a toy truck under a blanket. Find other hiding spots for the truck.
Sensory & Science	<b>Trucks in the Dirt</b> Make a sensory tub including dirt, rocks, and toy trucks and tractors. Let baby explore.	<b>Muddy Play</b> Provide chocolate pudding as "mud". Let baby explore using their hands.	<b>Fast &amp; Slow</b> Push toy vehicles around. Talk about how sometimes they go fast and sometimes they go slow. Practice both speeds.	<b>Light and Heavy</b> Explore weight using a variety of objects. Talk about what is light and what is heavy.	<b>Tool Play</b> While playing with toy tools, talk about the different jobs that use those tools like woodworker, mechanic, etc.

## Supplies Needed

Infant Plans are meant to give some structure and fun to a baby's day, while providing experiences to stimulate growth and learning.
