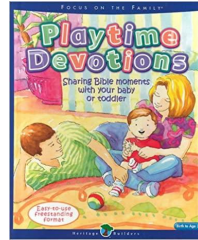

Fingerplays & Songs	Hickory Dickory Dock Hickory dickory dock. The mouse went up the clock. The clock struck one. The mouse went down. Hickory dickory dock. Tick tock, tick tock, tick tock, tick tock.	Humpty Dumpty Humpty Dumpty sat on a wall. Humpty Dumpty had a great fall. All the king's horses and all the king's men. Couldn't put Humpty together again.	A Sailor Went To Sea A sailor went to sea, sea, sea. To see what he could see, see, see. But all that he could see, see, see. Motor	Ready, Set, Go! Encourage gross motor skills while using listening skills. Say "Ready, set, Go!" and encourage baby to crawl or walk.	Egg Roll Use hands and arms to push objects. Encourage baby to roll plastic eggs around the table or floor.	UP & Down Learn and repeat words. Raise arms up while saying the word, "up." Put arms down while saying the word, "down."	Boat Trip Set out a laundry basket. Encourage baby to get in the basket and sit and pretend they are in a boat.	Stars Are Shapes Explore shapes and sizes by exploring glow-in-the-dark stars.
Sensory & Science	Is It Soft or Rough? Sharpen tactile senses while exploring textures. Provide objects with different textures to explore. Talk about soft and rough.	What's Inside? Explore sound and cause and effect. Fill plastic eggs with a few Cheerios or fruit puffs. Shake them and ask, "What's inside?" Open the egg and show baby what is making the noise.	Paint With Water Use familiar objects for creative expression. Outside, use a paintbrush to "paint" with water on the sidewalk.	Boats Floats In a tub of water, experiment with objects to test what floats and what sinks. Use toy boats to demonstrate that boats float.	Star Prints Explore paint and creative expression. Use the glow-in-the-dark stars to paint. Dip the star into paint then press on paper.
