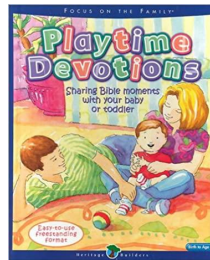

Sensory & Science	<b>Green Playdough</b> Feel and discover a new texture by playing with green playdough. Talk about the color.	<b>Colored Scarves</b> Feel and explore new textures by playing with colored scarves of all types.	<b>Painting with Green</b> Add green food coloring to vanilla pudding. Allow baby to explore the "paint".	<b>Colored Rainbow Streamers</b> Make streamers out of strips of cloth or crepe paper. Encourage baby to reach for the streamers as you shake them.	<b>Blowing Bubbles</b> Strengthen hand-eye coordination by reaching for bubbles.
